Plus, understanding the city, building a support system, and finding people that felt trustworthy and positive, not to mention finding ways to make a living before acting work kicked in. Adrienne said that she had booked her first acting job within about four or five months of arriving in LA. but didn't pay her bills by acting alone for a few more years. That meant a constant juggle of finding time and energy to grow your career, as well as time and energy to keep your head above water. She loves LA, but it can be a hard city to move to, as it is incredibly big, and

amazingly expensive. Adrienne's acting journey, like

most, has been full of highs and lows, successes and

heartbreaks, and so many 'almosts...' but the love of the craft just keeps her energized to continue pursuing the projects she loves and is most passionate about. VT: Is film the only passion of yours? Do you have any
